

Lithium Battery Module – LB3S

To whom it may concern,

This letter confirms that the lithium battery module designated LB3S has been tested in accordance with the United Nations Recommendation on the Transport of Dangerous Goods, Manual of Tests and Criteria (ST/SG/AC.10/11/Rev.5). The LB3S is designed for use with the SafeSea S100 SART.


Testing was performed by the Public Enterprise Testing Center <Omega> (Ukraine) under test report № 11/002 Issue 1.

The battery module successfully completed all tests and each battery has been categorized as containing less than two grams of lithium.

The battery module is considered 'Not Restricted' for transportation purposes and may be shipped under the following conditions.

- By road under the ADR regulations, special provision A188.
- By sea under the IMDG regulations, special provision A188.
- By air under the IATA regulations, packing instruction PI968 part 2 (batteries), PI969 part 2 (batteries packed with equipment) or PI970 part 2, (batteries contained in equipment).
